The parade starts on 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue from 57<sup>th</sup> Street to 79<sup>th</sup> Street. The Parade will begin at 12:00 pm (noon) with approximately forty-five minutes featuring the traditional Color Guards, Civic and Political Marchers. The Parade Float and Thematic Banners commence the creative aspect of the Parade at approximately 12:45 pm, until approximately 4:30 pm.

When you arrive at your assigned location, please make note of the group that is assigned to march before you (*Yeshiva Har Torah, Bayside, NY*) and which group is assigned to march after you (*Float –Banks*).

Our group is part of the Section "A" Marchers.

Section "A" Marchers assemble at W. 52<sup>nd</sup> Street, between 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

Marchers enter from 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 52<sup>nd</sup> Street.

Assembly time and order of groups: 12: 45 pm

Projected step-off time: 1:15 pm.

### **RULES, PROCEDURES AND REMINDERS**

Baby Carriages not permitted in the march.

Banners need curved slits cut into the design for air to pass through.

Bottled water should be carried in waist fanny packs or small knapsacks.

Cellular phones not permitted in the march.

Gum Chewing not permitted in the march.

Stopping during the parade is not permitted other than to correct spacing.

No weapon of any kind, real or false is permitted.

80<sup>th</sup> Street will be the first available pedestrian street for turning off 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue following the completion of the march.

T- Shirts/Trousers should be coordinated and worn by every male group marcher.

For the women saris would be preferable.

Please telephone or email your confirmation by May 21<sup>st</sup> as we have to inform the organizers as well as coordinate other activities.

We urge every Indian Jewish member of the community to participate and make the presence of the Indian Jewish Community known in New York and the United States.
